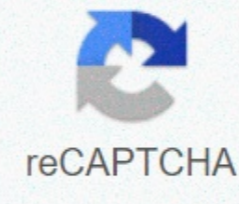

These professionals tend to the needs of children by managing and operating day care centers, or by working within those facilities to directly care for children. Their pay depends on job levels and employers. Jobs within this profession including staff-level day care providers, day care center directors and early childhood educators. Some people in this space own their own businesses, working out of their homes or a building they rent or own. Their pay depends on whether they are part-time contractors or full-time employees. Understanding the different types of jobs available in the day care profession will help you prepare yourself for employment and determine which employment options are right for you. Day care directors coordinate the activities of child care workers and preschool teachers at their facilities. They establish budgets and revenue goals, develop methods of reaching business targets, create educational programs and standards, and hire and train new staff members. They may own their own facilities, or run centers owned by others. Preschool and child care center directors made a median annual pay of \$48,210 per year, or \$23.18 per hour as of May 2019, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The BLS predicts that jobs for this profession will grow at 1 percent between 2019 and 2020, which is slower than the average growth in jobs predicted for all occupations. Because these professionals are usually employees, they might also receive benefits such as health insurance and retirement account contributions, such as to a 401(k) plan or pension. A degree in childhood education or business is helpful for climbing the ladder to these positions. You might consider a degree in one and a certificate in the other. You can also become a day care center director by opening your own business. You can go it on your own, or take the more expensive route of running a franchise. To determine whether or not opening your own day care center is worth it, you'll need to write a business plan and plug in the numbers for your area. In 2019, the median pay for child care workers was \$24,230 per year, or \$11.65 per hour. Employment of child care workers will increase by 2 percent from 2019 to 2029, according to the BLS, slower than the average job growth predicted for all occupations. Day care worker pay varies widely, based on your geographic area and type of employer you have. Staff-level day care workers have the option of working in private home day care settings, at local day care centers, or at day care facilities provided by businesses, colleges and universities, hospitals, military bases, law firms and other large workplaces. Child care workers monitor and supervise children in their care; develop schedules for playing, eating and resting; and change the diapers of toddlers and babies. They also keep records of their charges, look for signs of any emotional or developmental problems, and bring any issues to the attention of the day care administrator or parents. You can enter the day care profession with just a high school diploma, according to the BLS, but many employers prefer at least an associate's degree. Coursework in child care is helpful, as are certificate courses in CPR and child first-aid. Depending on the state where you live, you might need to get certain vaccinations and join a nationally recognized organization. According to the BLS, many states require earning a credential like the Council for Professional Recognition's Child Development Associate credential. Are you about starting a daycare business? These six children are counted regardless of the relationship they have to the caregiver, it could be some of her kids or those of clients or relatives, it does not matter. Again, in a Type B childcare center, only three of the children may be allowed to be under 2 years old so that the provider can take adequate care of them.When it comes to how much you can earn as a type B childcare provider, you should know that it depends on the going rate in the state or county you find yourself.So you might have five daycare children and one of your own for a total of six children. Five paying children at \$45 a day would be \$1125.00 a week. But you should know that this statistics depends on how much you choose to charge per child, and how many children in the care home are yours.
